Scotwind Announcement January 2022


- 17 new offshore windfarm projects have been awarded, and have now been offered option agreements which reserve the rights to specific areas of seabed
- Extensive requirement for offshore support
- Initial indications suggest a multi-billion pound supply chain investment in Scotland
- Nexans shall be a key player in tier 1 tender process
- Future opportunities are substantial!

- Installation of 2-off 245 kV export cables
- Survey activities:
 - Pre-lay Survey
 - PLGR (Prelay Grapnel Run)
- Cable lay with Skagerrak including burial
- Remedial protection:
 - Rock installation
 - Concrete Matresses
 - Rockbags








Offshore Scope of Work – Moray West (continued)

Landfall Activities:

- HDD, 1st end pull-in and jointing
- Diving activities

OSP Activities:

Pull-in, hang-off, stripping and termination
